
Parking and Public Transport Options

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Elizabeth Quay Train Station

A short 5-minute walk to the PCEC. Services both the Joondalup Line & Mandurah Line

Elizabeth Quay Bus Station

A short 2-minute walk to the PCEC

ACCESSIBILITY

Registration will take place on Level 3 in the foyer outside of the BelleVue Ballroom

Drop Off & Pick Up

The main drop off and pick up location is via the Plaza entry adjacent to the Adina Apartment Hotel Perth and provides direct access to Level 1. Take the stairs/escalators up to Level 3 of the PCEC to reach registration.

Pedestrian Entrance

The main pedestrian entrance is a short walk from St Georges Terrace or the bus port via Mill St, the connecting walkways. This entrance will provide direct access to Level 2, to reach registration take the stairs/escalators up to Level 3 of the PCEC.
