

Noodle Wheat Update Western Australia

This industry update is provided by the Wheat Council of the Grain Industry Association of Western Australia Inc (GIWA) under the Noodle Wheat Industry Communications Protocol between Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) and the Japan Flour Millers' Association (JFMA), and the Australian Export Grains Innovation Centre (AEGIC), CBH Group and GIWA, as at Thursday 29th February 2024.

Segregation update for noodle wheat blend to Japan: 80% ANW:20% APWN

- The blend ratio has been reviewed in January 2024. It is forecast that there is sufficient supply volumes of ANW and APWN and therefore the blend ratio will remain unchanged at:
 - 80% ANW 1 & ANW 2**
 - 20% APWN**
 - Min protein 10% / max protein 11.2%**
- The changes to protein limits shown above are expected to take affect with March 2024 tenders.
- Growers are reminded that Calingiri can no longer be received as ANW.
